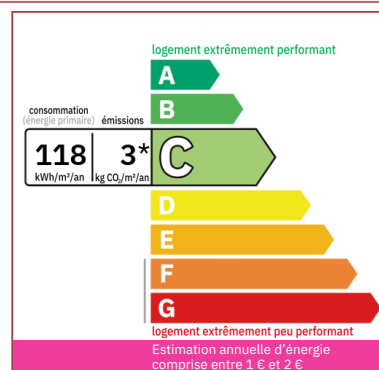

This beautiful historic house is accessed by a pretty stone staircase towards the entrance then to the impressive living room of 40m², very bright, which overflows with charm and taste, moldings, parquet flooring... then the kitchen of 23m² which overlooks the pretty courtyard of 25m²

From the entrance a wooden staircase of the time leads to the first floor and the landing/

Monflanquin, a magnificent perched medieval village, dating from 1256, is classified as "one of the most beautiful villages in France", with its dominant views of the rolling countryside, landscapes described by the writer Stendhal as those of a "little Tuscany".

It bears witness to a history which, in the Middle Ages, shaped the southwest of France.

There are many independent restaurants, cafes and shops within walking distance of the property, as well as the weekly farmers market.

The town of Villeneuve-sur-Lot is 18km away and Bergerac and its airport is approximately 40 minutes with flights to the UK, Belgium and Holland....

The cities of Bordeaux, listed by UNESCO and Toulouse are less than 2 hours away. (LGV)
